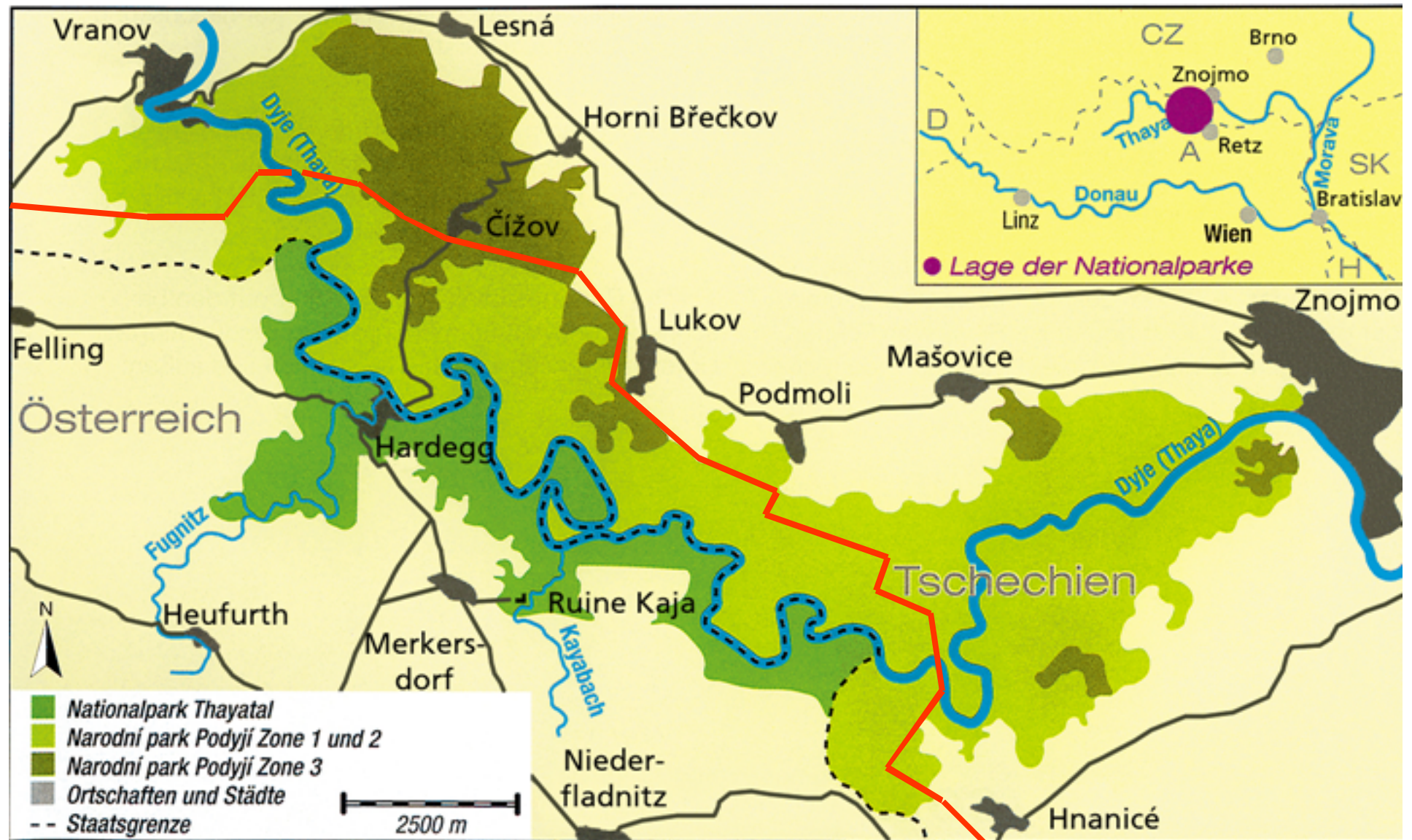

The general objectives of the national parks are:

- to preserve and develop the specificities of the habitat and promote biodiversity and self regulation;
- to eliminate or reduce the negative effects of historical and current anthropogenic interferences;
- to provide an opportunity for recreation and experiencing nature;
- to improve the quality of life of the inhabitants and the visitors;
- to deepen the knowledge on ecosystemic connections;
- to perform as a transborder protected area of European importance in future.



The success of the national park rests on two pillars:

The free development of nature

- by securing dynamics largely unaffected by Man;
- through comprehensive habitat protection;
- by promoting species diversity.

The partnership between the local population and visitors,

- through open relationships between all interest groups;
- through open discussions on the objectives;
- through various forms of high-quality information for the public.













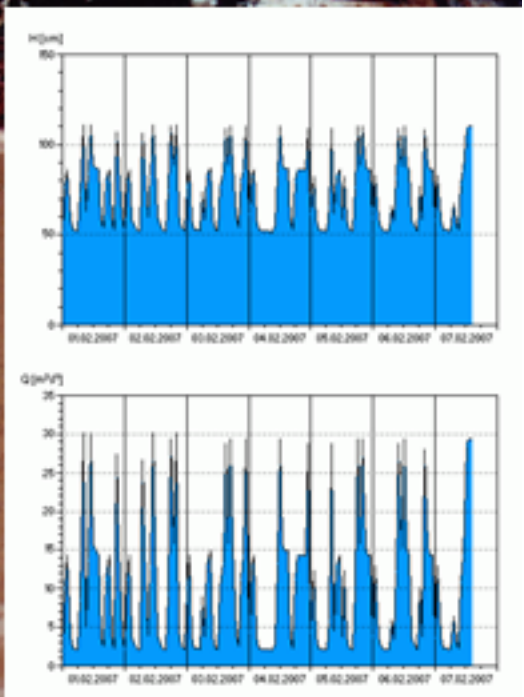
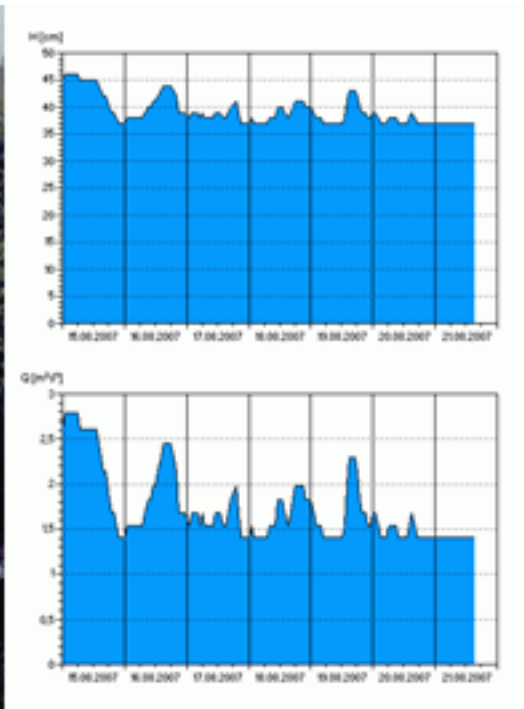
Fishing preserves in the Thayatal National Parks



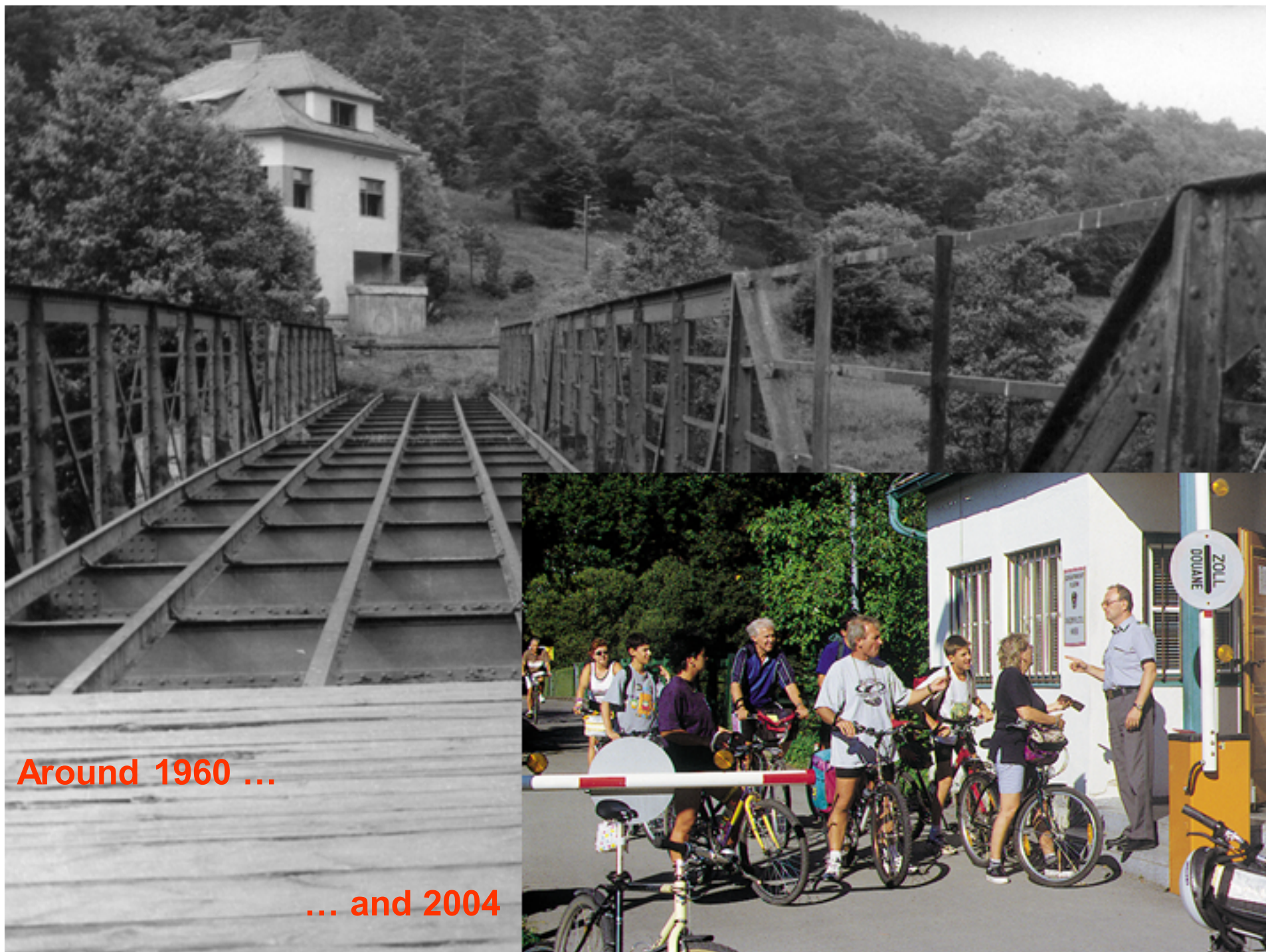




Inflow to the lake
